IMPORTANT NOTICE

- **This form is for registration in to the qualification process for the MSA British Cadet Kart Championship.**
- **Cost of entry in to each qualification meeting is laid out in the individual event entry forms.**
- **Entry forms for each qualification meeting will be sent out separately to registered competitors.**
- **You do not have to enter both events.**

- Dates and Venues are provisional subject to change.
- The MSA British Cadet Kart Championship is for karts conforming to Formula Comer Cadet.
- Competitors in the MSA British Cadet Kart Championship must attain their 9th birthday prior to competing in a round of the Championship, and be in possession of an MSA Kart National A licence (minimum), and must provide written evidence of having competed in a minimum of five Kart races since issued a National A kart licence. However, competitors may participate in these qualification events in anticipation of reaching their 9th birthday, and/or obtaining their MSA Kart National A licence in the 2010 season of FKS.
- Places in MSA British Cadet will be determined on the basis of performance. New competitors will be required to qualify. 2009 competitors need not qualify providing they secure their place by 29 November 2009. The number of open places will be determined on 1 December 2009 and advertised on the Championship website.
- The qualification meetings for MSA British Cadet are Larkhall on 17 January 2010 and Buckmore Park on 21 February 2010 (revised schedule). The cost of these qualification meetings are not included in the Registration Fee. Competitors are required to register separately with the championship prior to taking part in any qualification meeting (additional fee of £25). Registrations close one week prior to the events. The main Championship Registration fees are not payable until after a competitor qualifies. The results of the A-Final will be used to determine who qualifies for the championship. 50% of the places available will be awarded at the first meeting, and 50% at the second.
- Your entry will be acknowledged by email confirmation of your driver number.
- Championship Regulations will be available for download from www.formulakartstars.com
- No refunds of the Qualification Registration fee are permissible.
- The Championship reserves the right to refuse an entry.
- All communication will be by email.
- The Qualification Registration fee does not include the race meetings fees, or practice days.
